**Duties:** Serves as subject matter expert or technical advisor on Signal Intelligence (SIGINT) in support of intelligence research and information operations. Provides technical guidance in the planning, implementation, and maintenance of databases supporting intelligence operations needed to process SIGINT material on current intelligence, estimative intelligence, and finished intelligence. Applies technical expertise in the collection, analysis, and reporting of multi-mode SIGINT sources (e.g., communication intelligence or COMINT, electronic intelligence or ELINT, foreign instrumentation signals intelligence or FISINT) in order to assess the relevance of developments in assigned area(s), to prepare new or revised intelligence products (e.g., briefings, databases, estimates), and to forecast foreign intelligence and military intelligence. Maintains liaison with personnel in intelligence community to discuss support strategies and methodologies in SIGINT intelligence research and operations.
