Duties: Serves as Critical Infrastructure Protection (CIP), Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and Information Operations (IO) Technical Subject Matter Expert (SME) and section supervisor for the CIP/SCADA Support Section, IOVAD, U.S. Army 1st Information Operations Command (Land). Plans, coordinates, and oversees the execution of CIP/SCADA and IO signature characterization, collection management, analysis, processing, and dissemination of combat, strategic, and tactical military intelligence. Serves as technical SME in the collection, analysis and dissemination of tactical, operational, and strategic HUMINT, SIGINT, IMINT, and MASINT operations focused on CIP and IO. Plans and coordinates Team and Division CIP/SCADA which include analysis for friendly SCADA and information systems to determine vulnerabilities to human, signals, signatures, and imagery intelligence collection, and recommends appropriate countermeasures. Researches methodologies, tools, techniques and procedures.

Must be able to obtain and maintain a TOP SECRET - Special Access Security Clearance as a result of current and favorable Special Background Investigation. *TDY may constitute 25% or more of the work schedule both within and outside Continental United States. *Specialized experience is extensive, comprehensive knowledge and experience in applying current CIP/SCADA, IO, and Command and Control (C2P) directives and policies administered from the National, DA and MACOM levels; awareness of significant CIP, IO and C2P events and potential Counterintelligence developments; experience in planning, coordinating, and determining operational and resource requirements; extensive knowledge of the Information Operations C2 attack and C2 protect process; expertise in IO techniques, concepts, and elements (EW, OPSEC, PSYOP, Deception, and Destruction) and the innovative implementation of IO capabilities.

- GG-12 and above: One year of specialized experience directly related to the position being filled and equivalent to the next lower grade level. There is no substitution of education for experience at this level.
- Progressively responsible experience is that which has included intelligence-related research, analysis, collections and /or operations. At the GS-11 level and above it should have included intelligence analysis and/or production, intelligence collection and/or operations, counterintelligence, or threat support directly related to the position to be filled. Creditable specialized experience may include previous military intelligence experience, experience gained in the private sector or in another government agency as long as it was at a level at least equivalent to the next lower grade in the series. This experience should demonstrate: Knowledge of intelligence processes, cycle and organizations; Knowledge of and/or ability to use research tools such as library holdings, photographs, statistics, graphics and maps; Knowledge of the systems, procedures and methods of analyzing, compiling, reporting and disseminating intelligence data; and/or Knowledge of organization(s) for and methods of collecting and analyzing intelligence data.
