Identifies and supports theater Information Systems Security certification and accreditation issues. Provides support and technical expertise to the theater commands constituency on hardware/software required for regulatory compliance. Develops software security tools to monitor/analyze unauthorized activity on servers/networks. Responsible for software evaluations, configurations and quality assurance for developed security software modules. Manages contract support staff. Designs automated tools for incident response. Resolves computer emergency problems. Responds to network/system breaches (actual or attempted intrusion, computer viruses, worms, Trojan horses, etc.). Performs on-site or remote diagnostic and troubleshooting on systems. Conducts and/or oversees Vulnerability Assessment Certification for staff and constituency.

**General Schedule**

- Applicants claiming Veterans Preference must submit required paperwork at the time of selection. Temporary duty to worldwide locations may be required up to 20% of the time. Shift work may be required during contingency operations. Specialized experience is knowledge of state-of-the-art computer standards, network design, operating systems, interfacing requirements, software applications and computer techniques, requirements, methods and hardware; system administration functions for AIS; evaluate the need for threat and vulnerability assessments, systems change proposals, etc.; the design of AIS security policies and specific systems security programs using a comprehensive, integrated and systematic application of multiple automation security disciplines; and the ability to conduct research and determine the need for and develop requests for exceptions to automation security policies.

- GS-12 and above: One year of experience directly related to the occupation and equivalent to at least the next lower grade level. There is no substitution of education for experience at this level.
- The experience described in your resume will be evaluated as related to the qualifications, knowledge, skills and abilities required for this job.
